
Designated Roads, Trails and Camping Areas in Grasmere - Dorr Road




* Koocanusa Recreation Management Area: Effective April 8, 2020, a Recreation Order is in effect for the Koocanusa Recreation Management Area. Motorized recreation is limited to designated roads and trails, and Crown land camping is only permitted in designated sites. The Order is intended to protect environmental and cultural values, and to enable regulation of public recreation use of the area, and is consistent with direction provided by the current Koocanusa Recreation Strategy. The Order was implemented by the Ministry of Forests, Lands, Natural Resource Operations and Rural Development under Section 58 of the Forest and Range Practices Act, in partnership with the Conservation Officer Service, the RCMP, the Ktunaxa Nation and the Tobacco Plains Indian Band, as well as other local government stakeholders in the region.
